Camp Overview

We are excited to offer another summer of camp for kids ages **5-12 years old!** Camp is hosted within Palmyra-Macedon Intermediate school for the first 6 weeks (7/3-8/11) and at Bullis Park in the Back Pavilion for the 7th final week (8/14-8/18). Activities, crafts, and games will be offered in-house, including painting, drawing, gym games, board/ card games, field days, water days, tie dye, library days, talent show, movies, and more. There are also many field trip opportunities.

New This Year

This year, we are offering more FIELD TRIP opportunities in addition to in-house activities. On the following page, be sure to check out dates for field trips and activities. Please note: field trips are an additional charge. After registration, a detailed camp calendar with field trip times and information will be sent out to parents and guardians. Also, we will be offering **EXTENDED HOURS** at an additional cost. Regular camp hours will be from 8:00am-4:00pm, and extended hours are 7:30am-5:00pm. Lastly, camp will be **7 WEEKS** this year! Camp will run for one week longer into August than in previous years.

What to Bring

We ask each camper to come to camp each day ready, to move, play, and be comfortable! Your child should come to camp with; lunch, a snack, sunscreen, water bottle, and extra clothes. **Please leave all electronic devices at home!** If you want your child to have a cell phone with them, please be aware we ask for it to remain in their bag. Camp Counselors

Our counselor to camper ratio is typically 1:8-10. Staff is trained prior to camp on expectations, restorative practices, and strategies to positively redirect, remind, and reinforce appropriate behavior. Expectations are introduced to campers, and staff will be constantly modeling them as well. We expect appropriate behavior to be maintained while we are on field trips and away from the school. For the safety of staff and campers, please be aware that if your child cannot follow camp expectations and compromises others safety, you will be required to pick up your



child. If your child is asked to be picked up from camp more than once, they may be prevented from returning to camp. Please note that we are willing to do whatever it takes to make your child's experience at camp fun and exciting while upholding the same commitment to other children.

How to Register

Registration will be available on <u>macedonrec.com</u> (Macedon Recreation website). From here, you can register for a few different options. Field trip registration will also be available at the time of registering for camp. If you do not register for field trips at the time of registration, we cannot guarantee a spot for your child on that field trip once camp starts. As a reminder, field trips are an additional cost.
